The 2010 U11, U13, U15, U17 JIT results will determine the Under-11, Under-13, Under-15 and Under-17 junior athletes who will represent the United States in the Pan American Junior Championship individual events (August 8-11, 2010, in Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic – see www.badmintonpanam.org for latest update). The U.S. may enter up to 4 singles, 2 doubles pairs, and 4 mixed double pairs in each individual event per age category. Players cannot play in more than one singles event, one doubles event, or one mixed doubles event. **Please note: There is no USAB funding designated for this International event.**

Trials for the 2010 Under-19 Pan American Junior Championships and the 2010 World Junior team and individual events were already held separately on December 30, 2009 – January 1, 2010.

The following criteria will be used in qualification in each age category:

1. The top 4 finishers in **boy's singles** will have first priority to enter that individual event. If there are any openings, then the next player with the highest rank order from the trial results in boy's singles will make that individual event.
2. The top 4 finishers in **girl's singles** will have first priority to enter that individual event. If there are any openings, then the next player with the highest rank order from the trial results in girl's singles will make that individual event.
3. The top 2 finishers in **boy's doubles** will have first priority to enter that individual event. If there are any openings, then the next team with the highest rank order from the trial results in boy's doubles will make that individual event. Double teams qualify as a pair – if one player cannot make it, then the other player loses his spot.
4. The top 2 finishers in **girl's doubles** will have first priority to enter that individual event. If there are any openings, then the next team with the highest rank order from the trial results in girl's doubles will make that individual event. Double teams qualify as a pair – if one player cannot make it, then the other player loses her spot.
5. The top 4 finishers in **mixed doubles** will have first priority to enter that individual event. If there are any openings, then the next team with the highest rank order from the trial results in mixed doubles will make that individual event. Double teams qualify as a pair – if one player cannot make it, then the other player loses her spot.
6. If all trial results/rankings have been used and there are still additional spots, the USAB Junior committee shall have the discretion to fill the vacant spots.
7. The trial results will be used for the rank order of the players/teams to be submitted to the Pan Am Junior organizers.

Included in the entry fee is \$40.00 per person that will go towards supporting the USAB coaching staff going to the Pan Am Juniors. The Pan American Badminton Confederation limits the number of coaching credentials, and parent coaches may not be allowed depending on the discretion of the tournament referee.

Events: BS, GS, BD, GD, and MX in the following age categories: U17, U15, U13, and U11. Player's age must be under the age category as of December 31, 2010. Each player may enter a maximum of 3 events. Players cannot play in more than one singles event, one doubles event, or one mixed doubles event.
Deadline: Entries must be received by January 22, 2010. LATE ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

Entry Fees: \$80.00 per person for up to 3 events. **Makes checks payable to Orange County Badminton Club (OCBC). Please note: If you live outside of California, the entry fee is \$40.00 only.**

All entries must also include a \$100.00 per person deposit. **Make checks payable to USA Badminton.** The \$100 deposit is refunded unless you qualify for an event and do not participate in the Pan American Junior Championships.

Mail entries to Orange County Badminton Club, 1432 N. Main St., Orange, CA 92867. Entries must include the completed entry form with parent signature, the entry fee, the USAB deposit and a copy of the ID page of your passport.

Eligibility: All entrants must be USAB members in good standing who are able to represent the United States of America per BWF regulations: U.S. citizen or on BWF International Representation waiver list. All entrants must be committed to travel & represent the U.S. in one/both events. All entrants must attach passport copy with entry form to confirm citizenship & ability to travel.
