

2010 Direct Athlete Support

Stipulations – Athletes receiving direct athlete support must be currently training and competing, agree to train full-time, and sign individual performance standards and an athlete agreement developed with the pentathlon coach. In addition, athletes must agree to observe all USADA, WADA and UIPM rules, regulations and procedures.

Athletes receiving direct athlete support in 2010 will receive funding based on the table below resulting from their placement at the 2009 Senior World Championships.

ELITE ATHLETE HEALTH INSURANCE (EAHI)

A. Number of EAHI slots allocated: 4

B. Eligibility and Criteria Approved for EAHI:

EAHI will be offered to qualified athletes who are actively training and competing, according to the process outlined below:

1. Slots will be offered to the top finishers, regardless of gender, at the most recent UIPM Modern Pentathlon Senior World Championships.
2. If slots remain, they will be offered to those athletes in the Top 50, in rank order, on the UIPM Ranking List.

Should there be any available EAHI slots left after the eligible athletes have either accepted or declined, those remaining slots will go unused.
