



USAB Head Coach For 2010 World Junior Championships

Details -

Dates: April 16-25, April 2010 (possible travel on 14 and return on 22 or after the World Junior Championships)

Location: Guadalajara, Mexico

- USA Badminton shall provide a stipend for your meals.
- USAB shall organize your travel and accommodation.

Job description

- Serve as USA Head Coach for the World Junior Championship (WJC)
- Assist the Team Manager where possible in the role of Assistant Team Manager if the Team Manager has other duties
- Provide leadership; keep team together as USA Team irrespective of players' clubs
- Guide and work with the Assistant Coach(es)
- Provide consistent and positive coaching to all USA players
- Provide off court coaching advice to every player in a fair manner
- If possible video tape matches of opponents for off court coaching and guidance sessions with USA players
- Provide guidance to players so that the WJC becomes a learning process
- Assist the Team Manager in completing a tournament report (template to be provided by office) and submit to the office not later two (2) weeks after the competition has ended
- Work with the Assistant Coach(es) and Team Manager to complete a performance report on the USA players
- Assist the Team Manager in submitting short daily articles to the USAB Office for website posting (include pictures) where possible
- Guide players to be fair and respectful of team mates, fellow players, other coaches, officials and organizers
- And any other responsibilities as deemed suitable and necessary

Expectation

- Sign a USAB Coach Agreement document and be aware that they represent the USA upon accepting the post.
- Answerable to the USAB throughout the competition
- Cooperative and respectful to fellow coaches, players, officials and organizers

Applying coaches must meet the following criteria

- Must be coaching and living in the USA
- Must have a minimum USAB Level 3 Certificate Coach (see footnote)
- Must have led USA teams as head coach or assistant coach
- Experienced in international competition coaching
- Has current experience in managing and coaching young players
- Able to speak and write English
- Able to work in difficult circumstances
- Proactive and able to solve problems

How to apply

Submit a resume of your coaching experience and a headshot (JPEG format) to Mohan Subramaniam, USA Badminton - Director, Coaching & High Performance (DCHP) at mohan@usabadminton.org and no later than Monday February 8, 2010.

Selection

- Coaches will be selected by Mohan Subramaniam - Director, Coaching & High Performance in with consultation with Fred Coleman (Chair, Junior Advisory Group) and the Team Manager (to be named)
- Applications may also be reviewed by selected members of the High Performance Advisory Group (HPAG) and / the Coaching Advisory Group (CAG)

Footnote

A Certified Coach is a coach who is actively coaching, has current USAB membership and has a current background check on file as required.
