- Entry Forms:** *All entry forms can be found at www.usaboxing.org. Please go online and print them off.*
- Event Description:** *Open to all male and female athletes that were born between January 1st, 1992 and December 31st, 1993. This age determination date has been set by AIBA and is aligned with the 2010 Youth World Championships taking place in April, 2010. Must be a U.S. Citizen, and have at least 5 open bouts and be a current member of USA Boxing. All will be responsible for their own housing and meal accommodations. The champions in the men's division will qualify to represent Team USA at the 2010 AIBA Youth World Championships in Baku, Azerbaijan on April 20 – May 2, 2010.*

- Entry Deadline: **All entries must be sent to USA Boxing Events no later than Friday, February 5, 2010.** If you would like to register after the January 29 deadline please call the National Office. Forms can be faxed directly to USA Boxing at (719) 632-3426. Mail all entries to: USA Boxing Event, 1 Olympic Plaza, Colorado Springs, CO 80909.
- Registration: **Registration will take place on Monday, February 8th from 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. at the Hyatt Regency Hotel.** There will be an individual area set up for the USA Boxing Under-19 National Championships to check-in and verify their information with tournament officials. You must provide your current passbook in order to participate. ***NO BOOK – NO BOX!!!***
- If you are delayed due to weather or flight delays please call Allan Nader at 240-538-1858 immediately.***
- All ATHLETES must have five registered bouts in order to compete. Walkovers and/or unopposed wins do not count toward the 5-bout rule.**
- Registration Fee: **USAB HAS DECIDED TO EXCLUDE THE REGISTRATION FEE FOR THIS EVENT. IF YOU SENT IN A REGISTRATION FEE IT WILL BE RETURNED TO YOU DURING REGISTRATION.**
- Athlete Participant Age: ***Athletes must be born between January 1, 1992 through December 31, 1993.***
- USA Boxing Membership: Each tournament participant (Boxers, Coaches, Officials, Physicians, Tournament Administration, etc.) must be registered with USA Boxing for the 2010 membership year, and have proof of registration (Registration Pink Copy, Membership Card, Passbook Validation Stamp). Coaches MUST be currently certified to work and all officials must submit an Officials Referral Form signed by the LBC President.
- Citizenship Required: Citizenship is required of all participants in the tournament. Permanent residency is no longer sufficient. Birth certificates and citizenship are required in order to secure passports and visas. It is suggested that all participants bring an original birth certificate or proof of citizenship.
- Travel: All participants are responsible for their own travel to and from the USA Boxing Under-19 National Championships. USA Boxing is working with the local organizing committee to arrange transportation to and from the airport. Participants not staying at the host hotel are responsible for their own transportation to and from the venue. Do not make your airline departure reservations prior to Saturday, February 13, 2010. We will not be able to change bouts to accommodate early departures.
- Event Officials: All officials will be assigned to this event by USA Boxing before the event dates, and USA Boxing will attempt to provide room and board. ***If you are not selected and wish to participate please contact Angel Villarreal at algvillarreal@yahoo.com for more information.*** Officials must be registered with USA Boxing for the 2010 membership year, and be

currently certified as a **minimum Level II Official**. **All officials must provide a completed official referral form signed by their LBC President.**

- Draw & Bracketing:** The draw will be conducted Monday, February 8 at 8:00 p.m. This will be a computer draw, and brackets will be posted following the draw and meeting. All participants and coaches must be present to verify participation.
- Conduct & Discipline:** Individuals deemed guilty of misconduct will be immediately barred from all tournament facilities and required to leave at their own expense. All participants (athletes, coaches, officials, team managers, etc.) must adhere to the USA Boxing Code of Conduct.
- Trial Scale:** A trial scale will be available at various times throughout the tournament. The times will be posted during Registration.
- Weights (lbs.):** Men (11 classes): 106, 112, 119, 125, 132, 141, 152, 165, 178, 201, 201+
Female (11 classes): 101, 106, 112, 119, 125, 132, 141, 152, 165, 178, 178+
- Round Lengths:** **Male: Three, three-minute rounds with 1-minute rest period in-between rounds.**
Female: Four, two-minute rounds with 1-minute rest period in-between rounds.
- Awards:** Outstanding Boxer Awards for both the male and female tournaments.
Individual Weights: Gold, Silver, and 2 Bronze medals in each weight class.
- Weigh-ins and Physicals:** Each boxer must satisfactorily complete weigh-ins and physicals each day that he/she competes. Please remember to have all athletes at the start of weigh-ins as the order is random. Weigh-ins will start at 7:00am and end at 9:00am on all competition days. Trial scales will be provided prior to each official weigh-in. ***There is no weight allowance and no change in weight class from the entry form.***
- Equipment:** USA Boxing will provide gloves, tape, and gauze. All other items (headgear, foul-proof cups, breast protectors, form-fitted mouthpieces, uniforms, sponges, water bottles, etc.) must be provided by the participants. Boxers must wear headgear made to USA Boxing's specifications.
