



USAB Team Leader / Coach For 2010 Youth Olympic Games (YOG)

Details -

Dates: August 14-26, 2010 (may travel before 14th and return after 26th)
Location: Singapore

- All expenses on travel, accommodation and meals shall be covered by the USOC and / USAB.

Who Should apply

This position is only for USAB High Performances (HP) coaches who have led USA teams for world class events and have previously been the head coach or assistant coach in the Youth Olympic Games Qualifiers, World Junior Championships, World Championships, Thomas Cup, Uber Cup, Sudirman Cup, Pan American Games (or equivalent Continental Championships), or Olympic Games.

Job description

- Serve as USA Team Manager and Head Coach for the YOG
- Manage and coach with regards to all matters such as accommodation, internal travel, injury and medical needs.
- The team shall comprise of a maximum of two (2) players; either a boy or a girl or both.
- Organize and coordinate all matters related to the YOG with USAB and / USOC
- Provide consistent and positive coaching
- Provide off court coaching advice to every player in a fair manner
- If possible video tape matches of opponents for off court coaching and guidance sessions with USA players
- Provide guidance to players so that the YOG becomes a learning process
- Communicate with parents and office in an emergency
- Communicate with all player(s) and parents before going to the YOG
- Update USAB Office daily by email regarding players' performance and results where possible
- Coordinate travel if necessary
- Complete a tournament report (template to be provided by office) and submit to the office not later two (2) weeks after the competition has ended
- Submit articles for the USAB website (include pictures)
- Guide players to be fair and respectful of team mates, fellow players, other coaches, officials and organizers
- Any other responsibilities deemed necessary

Expectation

- Meet the requirements as stated in the 2010 YOG Team Leader/Coach Selection Procedure as approved by the USOC
- Sign a USAB Coach Agreement document and be aware that they represent the USA upon accepting the post.
- Answerable to the USOC and / USAB throughout the competition
- Cooperative and respectful to fellow coaches, players, officials and organizers

Selection

The USAB Coaching Advisory Group shall select for nomination by February 26, 2010 the best candidate from the USAB HP coaches who have applied.
