Race Cut-Off Times

The race organizers have announced the cut-off times for this 3x Olympic distance event. Please be aware that the first wave start (M/F 55+) will begin at 7am and the second wave (M/F 18-54) will begin at 7:30am. The Bike and run cut-off times are the same for both wave starts.

Split	Time
Swim- First Wave	9:15am
Swim- Second Wave	9:45am
Cycle Turnpoint Oberstaufen (50km into bike portion)	11:45am
Finish 1st lap of Bike (85 km into bike portion)	1:15pm
End of Bike Portion (130km)	3:15pm
Finish 1st lap of run portion (20km)	5:10pm
Course and race closes	6:00pm

Entry Fee/Final Payment

The entry fee is going to be roughly \$250 USD. I will be emailing all registered participants in about a month with instructions on how to make this final payment.
