- Athletes:** Two-hundred wounded, injured and ill, servicemen and women from all branches of military service
- Dates:** May 10-14, 2010
- Location:** Colorado Springs, Colo.
- Venues:** The Warrior Games will utilize facilities at the following venues in Colorado Springs, Colo.:

  - United States Air Force Academy
  - Fort Carson
  - Memorial Park
- Sports (7):** Archery, cycling, basketball, shooting, swimming, track & field, volleyball
- Eligibility:** Competition for wounded, injured and ill service men and women with the following physical disabilities: amputations, spinal cord injuries, post traumatic stress disorder and traumatic brain injury (this category also includes cerebral palsy and stroke)
- Athlete Selection:** Athletes will be drawn proportionally from the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marine Corps and Coast Guard. Participants will be selected by each individual branch of service
- Organizers:** U.S. Paralympics, a division of the U.S. Olympic Committee, Department of Defense, USO, Ride to Recovery
- Admission:** Free and open to the public
