



**Modern Pentathlon World Cup 5
Women & Men
Berlin, Germany
03rd June – 06th June 2010
Berlin Olympic Park**

Dear Friends,

The German Modern Pentathlon Federation has the pleasure to invite – through the Berlin Association of Modern Pentathlon - a delegation of your country to participate in the Modern Pentathlon World Cup #5 for Women and Men that is going to be held in Berlin from June, 3rd to June, 6th - 2010 according to the following programme:

June, 2nd	Arrival of Delegations Technical Meeting Men & Women Qualification Competitions
June, 3rd	Men's Qualification Competition
June, 4th	Women's Qualification Competition Jumping Test Technical Meeting Men & Women Finals
June, 5th	Men's Individual Final
June, 6th	Women's Individual Final
June, 7th	Departure of Delegations

The World Cup in Berlin is scheduled to be the last competition before the World Cup Final that will take place in Moscow (from June, 18th to June, 20th - 2010). We expect about 25 nations to participate in the World Cup in Berlin. The competition will be run at the same historical Olympic venues already known from the successful World Championships 2007. Three qualification rounds for men and two qualification rounds for women are planned.

The German TV station ZDF intends to broadcast parts of the Women's Individual Final on Sunday.

RULES

The competition will be carried out according to the UIPM Rules.

Swimming: 50m outdoor swimming pool / 8 lanes – Forumbad Berlin

Fencing: 9 pistes – Horst Korber Sportzentrum

Combined Event: 36 electronic targets (CO2 and compressed air will be available);

sand and grass surface – Olympic Riding Arena

ECONOMICAL CONDITIONS

All participants will be accommodated at the Competition Hotels. Please note down on the Entry Form your choice of the hotel. The reservations for the hotels will be on first come first serve basis. The price includes full board accommodation, local transportation and entry to the competition. The costs of stay per person per night are:

When submitting Final Entry form C, Delegations are required to send by bank transfer at least a minimum of 30% of the total amount of their accommodation costs, otherwise the reservation will not be guaranteed.

When Final Entry Form C and the deposit (non-refundable) have been received we will send you an invoice of the remaining total for the stay of your Delegation. The remaining amount has to be paid by bank transfer by 26th of May or by cash (Euros only) at the accreditation desk on arrival. For your and our convenience we kindly ask you to make payment by transfer.

Nations wishing to arrange their own accommodation are required to notify the hosting NF/LOC. This must be recorded in Entry Forms A and B.

Nations wishing to arrange their own accommodation must pay 100 Euro accreditation fee per participant which is to be sent by bank transfer with the Final Entry Form C. This accreditation fee includes packed lunch for the two competition days and allows access to official transportation between the official competition hotels and the competition sites.

ENTRY FORMS

Entry Form A must be returned before 3rd of April.

Entry Form B must be returned before 21st of April.

The Final Entry Form C must be received by the LOC latest on May 12th at 12.00 p.m.

In case your Final Entry Form C will not be returned according to the above mentioned terms and / or there will not be any receipt of your Delegation's deposit payment on time, we assume that your delegation will not attend the event and all reservations made before will be cancelled.

Delegations are reminded of the new Rule 1.15.3

If on arrival for the competition, the team has less athletes and/or officials than listed on their Final Entry Form C and without having informed the Organising Nation/LOC at least 7 days prior to their arrival, the NF will pay a fine to the Organising Nation/LOC of 200 Euros for each person less.

Following confirmation of the final entries, a NF must enter the competition with at least one pentathlete. Any NF failing to take part after having sent their final entries will pay a fine of USD 750 to UIPM.

ATHLETES' LICENSES

Athletes are only allowed to participate in UIPM sanctioned events if they are in possession of a valid UIPM issued Athletes License. Entry Forms will not be accepted if any athlete is missing his/her License Number. Please contact immediately UIPM Headquarters if your athlete is missing his/her License.

Teams have to present the licenses to the LOC on their arrival.

If an athlete forgets their License, they must pay a fine of 50 Euros to the UIPM TD/NTO and this fine remains the property of UIPM.

If an athlete does not have a license and has not requested a license from UIPM they will not be allowed to take part in the competition.

You are reminded of new Rule 1.13:-

Pentathletes without riding ability listed on their License card and without a letter from their NF confirming their ability to ride:

- cannot compete in World Senior or Junior Championships nor the World Cup Final.
- may compete at World Cup competitions in the qualifications for the Final, but if they do qualify for the Final, they must relinquish their place to the next pentathlete who has the ability to ride.
- at all other events, may compete in all disciplines except the Riding.

EQUIPMENT CONTROL

- The equipment control for fencing will be made at the competition venue
- The control for the riding headgear will be made at the competition venue
- The pistol control will be made at competition venue before the combined event.

TRANSPORTATION PLAN

Transportation from the airport to the official hotels and the return journey are only guaranteed if flight information is provided with Entry Form C in good time and according to the deadline. Transportation from the official hotels to the venues for athletes will be according to the competition programme.

VISAS & VACCINATIONS

Visiting nations should confirm visa and vaccination requirements for entry into Germany prior travelling to the event. The LOC cannot accept responsibility for arranging visas but can provide specific letters of invitation if needed. For information if you need a visa or vaccinations please contact your nearest Embassy or Consulate.

INSURANCE

All members of the attending Delegations must insure themselves in case of accidental injury or illness. The organiser will not accept any responsibility financial or otherwise for loss, injury or illness of any Delegation member.

FIREARMS

Firearms Licenses are not a legal requirement when bringing air and CO2 pistols into Germany for competition purposes. In any case please indicate the serial numbers and the model of the firearms (Feinwerkbau, Steyr, Walther etc.) your athletes will bring to Berlin.

GENERAL INFORMATION

All athletes are kindly requested to wear their official national uniform at the competition. Please also bring a CD of your national anthem and a national flag.
