Schedule

Saturday PM	Open Mixed Team Round - YOG Elimination Rd
Sunday AM	Individual Elimination Matches (Set System) – All divisions

Format

Divisions

Compound

Recurve

Age Classification, Girl and Boy

Junior – Archers are eligible to shoot in the Junior Division through the calendar year of their 20th birthday (Born in or after 1990).

Cadet – Archers are eligible to shoot in the Cadet Division through the calendar year of their 17th birthday (Born in or after 1993).

Cub – Archers are eligible to shoot in the Cub Division through the calendar year of their 14th birthday (Born in or after 1996).

Bowmen - Archers are eligible to shoot in the Bowmen Division through the calendar year of their 12th birthday (Born in or after 1998).

Rounds

Bowmen (Recurve and Compound) will be shooting at 30m for all rounds; Qualification, Team, Open Mixed Team and the Individual Elimination Round using the Set System.

Cubs (Recurve and Compound) will be shooting at 50m for all rounds; Qualification, Team, Open Mixed Team and the Individual Elimination Round using the Set System.

Cadets (Recurve and Compound) will be shooting at 60m for all rounds; Qualification, Team, Open Mixed Team and the Individual Elimination Round using the Set System.

Juniors (Recurve and Compound) will be shooting at 70m for all rounds; Qualification, Team, Open Mixed Team and the Individual Elimination Round using the Set System.

Awards will be given to the top finishers in each round; Qualification, Team, Mixed Team and Individual Elimination.

JOAD National Champion

The JOAD National Champion will be crowned by taking the average of the archers' placements in the Qualification Round, Team Round and the Individual Elimination Round in all classes and divisions. All archers competing in the Team Round will receive a 1st place placement, regardless of where their team finishes. The Mixed Team Round will not be factored into the final National Champion results. The archer with the lowest average from all three rounds will be declared the overall JOAD National Champion in their class and division. If the archers' average is tied, the final placement from the Elimination Round will be used as the tie-breaker.

Team Round – JOAD Committee to review in order to eliminate cuts if possible

For the Team Round, depending on the number of archers in each division, the number of participants will be cut based on the qualification round to the highest possible of these combinations:

24 archers (8 teams of 3)

12 archers (4 teams of 3)

6 archers (2 teams of 3)

If there are fewer than 6 archers in any division, there will not be a team round for that division and all archers in that division will receive an automatic "0" for the Team Round.

If an archer fails to compete in the team round, they will receive the placement in the round equal to the cut number plus 1. For example, if the cut was 24 into the team round, all archers who did not complete the round, or did not make the cut would receive a finish of 25th for the team round. If the cut was 12, they would receive a placement of 13th, if the cut was 6, they would receive a placement of 7th, etc.

The 3 archer teams will be matched according to their placement in the qualification round.

Open Mixed Team Round

The Open Mixed Team Round is completely voluntary and no points will be awarded for participating in this event. A mixed team consists of a Male and a Female archer that shoots the same division (age group) and style of equipment. This event is being offered to bring more awareness to this format.
