Registration Deadline: Tuesday, June 1, 2010

All entries must be sent to USA Boxing Events no later than Tuesday, June 1, 2010. All participant paperwork and forms must be sent to USA Boxing at 1 Olympic Plaza, Colorado Springs, CO 80909.

Entry Deadline Penalty:

Any LBC/Region that does not meet the June 1 deadline, the LBC/Region may be subject to finding and paying their own housing and meals.

Registration/Arrival Date: July 11, 2010

Event Dates: July 12-17, 2010

Departure Date: July 18, 2010

Registration: Registration will take place on Sunday, July 11 from 12-6 p.m. at the U.S. Olympic Training Center. There will be an area set up for the USA Boxing National Championships Tournament Staff to check-in and verify all participant's information with tournament officials. You must provide current passbook in order to participate. NO BOOK... NO BOX!!!

If you are delayed due to weather or flight delays, the participant must call Tournament Director Joe Smith at (423) 400-8472

All athletes must have five registered bouts in order to compete. Walkovers and/or unopposed wins do not count towards the 5-bout rule.

Age Determination Date:

Athletes must be 17 years of age on August 1, 2010 and cannot exceed 34 years of age on August 1, 2010.

Number Rounds/Duration:

Males: Three, 3-minute rounds
Females: Four, 2-minute rounds

NOTE FOR MALE CHAMPIONS FROM THE 2009 USA BOXING NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS:

USA BOXING WILL ALLOW ALL MALE CHAMPIONS FROM THE 2009 NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS AN AUTOMATIC BID INTO THE 2010 NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS.

(Athletes must register for the 2010 USA Boxing National Championships in the same weight class that they competed at for the 2009 USA Boxing National Championships. If they can no longer compete in that weight class then they must qualify via a different avenue listed below. Athletes who won the 2009 National Championships at: 106lbs, 112lbs, 119lbs, 125lbs will be allowed to go up or down one weight class for the 2010 National Championships.)

Qualification Tournaments for Senior Males: (Qualify Only)

- 14 Regional Tournaments
- Police Athletic League Champions
- Air Force, Army, Marines, Navy
- Northern Michigan University Resident Program
- 2009 USA Boxing National Champions
- At-Large Athletes (Must apply through National Office)
- Independent Slot Athletes (Must apply through National Office)

Qualification Tournaments for Senior Females: (Open Event)

- 14 Regional Tournaments
- Police Athletic League Champions
- Air Force, Army, Marines, Navy
- Unattached Boxers (Any athlete who does not come via one of the above qualifiers). These individuals may have to find their own housing and meals for the tournament.

Tournament Draw:

The draw will take place the evening on Sunday, July 11 after registration is closed. The tournament will use the National Team Rankings to seed the 2010 USA Boxing National Championships.

USA Boxing Membership:

Each tournament participant (Boxers, Coaches, Officials, Physicians, Tournament Administration, etc.) must be registered with USA Boxing for the 2010 membership year, and have proof of registration (Registration Pink Copy; Membership Card; Passbook Validation Stamp). Coaches must be currently certified to work and all officials must submit an Officials Referral Form signed by the LBC president.

Citizenship Required:

Citizenship is required of all participants in the tournament. Permanent residency is no longer sufficient. Birth certificates and/or citizenship are required in order to compete. All athletes must bring an original certified birth certificate or proof of citizenship to registration.

Official Roster:

Each Regional Team can consist no more than:

- 2 coaches; 1 team manager; 1 official; 1 athlete per weight class.

If a female athlete is part of your delegation, we recommend that there must be at least one female adult (i.e. coach, team manager or official) as part of your registered delegation to be responsible for the female athlete(s).

- Travel:** All participants are responsible for their own travel to and from the USA Boxing National Championships. After an athlete is eliminated from the tournament, he/she is eligible to return home at their own expense.
- Housing:** All delegations will be housed at the U.S. Olympic Training Center for only members on the official roster. If you are not on the official registered team roster, you are responsible for all of your own transportation, housing and meal expenses.
- Host Hotel:** Crowne Plaza Colorado Springs

- Event Officials:** All officials are welcome to participate. If you are not listed on an Official Registered Roster, you are responsible for your own transportation, housing and meals. If you are not selected and wish to participate or need additional information please contact Angel Villarreal at algvillarreal@yahoo.com. Officials must be registered with USA Boxing for the 2010 membership year, and be currently certified as a minimum Level II Official. All officials must provide a completed official referral form signed by their LBC president and chief of official.
- Conduct & Discipline:** Individuals deemed guilty of misconduct will be immediately barred from all tournament facilities and required to leave at their own expense. All participants must adhere to the USA Boxing Code of Conduct, which must be signed and turned in upon event registration.
- Trials Scale:** A trial scale will be available at various times throughout the tournament. The times will be posted during Registration.
- Equipment:** USA Boxing will provide gloves, tape, gauze and headgear (if needed). All other items (foul-proof cups, breast protectors, form-fitted mouthpieces, uniforms, sponges, water bottles, etc.) must be provided by the participants. All headgear must be made to USA Boxing's specifications, if the athlete wants to wear his/her own.
- Advancing Tournament:** The winners of the Men's National Championships will qualify to represent Team USA at the European Tour that will require at least a one-month commitment. If the champion is unable to compete, the next highest place finisher will receive the opportunity.
- The winners of the Women's National Championships will qualify for the 2010 Women's World Championships in September. If the athlete is unable to make the commitment for this event, USA Boxing will select the next highest place finisher.
