



2010 Junior Olympic Nationals Fact Sheet



- Entry Forms:** All entry forms can be found at www.usaboxing.org. Please print them off.
- Event Description:** Open to qualifying male and female athletes who must be born between the dates of August 2, 1993 and August 1, 1995 and must be 15 or 16 years old. USA Boxing will allow ALL MALE CHAMPIONS from the 2009 Junior Olympic National Championships an automatic bid into the 2010 USA Boxing Junior Olympic National Championships, only if the athletes meet the age requirements.
- Returning 2009 National Champions are only eligible in the same weight class in 2010. If they can no longer compete in that weight class then the athlete must qualify through their local LBC path.

- Housing and meals will ONLY be available for the coaches, team manager, officials and athletes listed on the official registered roster of each delegation. If you are not on the official registered team roster you are responsible for all of your own transportation, housing and meal expenses.

- Official Roster: Each Regional team can consist of NO MORE than 2 coaches, 1 team manager, 1 official and 1 athlete per weight class. If a female athlete is part of your delegation, we recommend there must be at least one female adult (i.e. coach, team manager or official) as part of your registered delegation to be responsible for the female athlete(s).
- Entry Deadline: **All entries must be sent to USA Boxing Events no later than Friday, May 28, 2010.** Forms can be faxed directly to USA Boxing at (719) 632-3426. Mail all entries to: USA Boxing Events, 1 Olympic Plaza, Colorado Springs, CO 80909.
- Entry Deadline Penalty: Any LBC/Region that does not meet the May 28 deadline, the LBC/Region may be subject to finding and paying their own housing and meals.
- Registration: **Registration will take place on Monday, June 14th from 12:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. at Camp Lejeune.** There will be an individual area set up for the USA Boxing Junior Olympic Championships to check-in and verify their information with tournament officials. You must provide your current passbook in order to participate. ***NO BOOK – NO BOX!!!***
- If you are delayed due to weather or flight delays please call Debbie Holmes at 214-797-9953 immediately.***
- All ATHLETES must have five registered bouts in order to compete. Walkovers and/or unopposed wins do not count toward the 5-bout rule.**
- Registration Fee: **THERE IS NO REGISTRATION FEE FOR THIS EVENT.**
- Draw: The draw will take place the evening of Monday, June 19th after registration is closed at the competition site.
- Athlete Participation: ***ALL athletes must be born between the dates of August 2, 1993 and August 1, 1995 and be 15-16 years old on August 1, 2010.***
- USA Boxing Membership: Each tournament participant (Boxers, Coaches, Officials, Physicians, Tournament Administration, etc.) must be registered with USA Boxing for the 2010 membership year, and have proof of registration (Registration Pink Copy, Membership Card, Passbook Validation Stamp). Coaches MUST be currently certified to work and all officials must submit an Officials Referral Form signed by the LBC President.

Citizenship Required:	Citizenship is required of all participants in the tournament. Permanent residency is no longer sufficient. Birth certificates and citizenship are required in order to secure passports and visas. It is suggested that all participants bring an original birth certificate or proof of citizenship.
Travel:	All participants are responsible for their own travel to and from the USA Boxing Junior Olympic Championships. USA Boxing is working with the local organizing committee to arrange transportation to and from the airport. Participants not staying at the host hotel are responsible for their own transportation to and from the venue. Do not make airline reservations to arrive at Camp Lejeune prior to Monday, June 14, 2010. We will not change bouts to accommodate early departures.
Event Officials:	All officials are welcome to participate. If you are not listed on an Official Registered Roster you are responsible for your own transportation, housing and meals. <i>If you are not selected and wish to participate or need additional information please contact Angel Villarreal at algvillarreal@yahoo.com or Tournament Chief of Official, Tom Cleary, at d2cleary@aol.com for additional information.</i> Officials must be registered with USA Boxing for the 2010 membership year, and be currently certified as a minimum Level II Official . All officials must provide a completed official referral form signed by their LBC President and Chief of Official.
Conduct & Discipline:	Individuals deemed guilty of misconduct will be immediately barred from all tournament facilities and required to leave at their own expense. All participants (athletes, coaches, officials, team managers, etc.) must adhere to the USA Boxing Code of Conduct.
Trial Scale:	A trial scale will be available at various times throughout the tournament. The times will be posted during Registration.
Weights (lbs.):	Men (17 classes): 90, 95, 101, 106, 110, 114, 119, 125, 132, 138, 145, 154, 165, 176, 189, 201, 201+ <i>Male athletes must be greater than 85 lbs. to compete in the 90 lbs. weight class.</i> Female (18 classes): 80, 85, 90, 95, 101, 106, 110, 114, 119, 125, 132, 138, 145, 154, 165, 176, 189, 189+ <i>Female athletes must be greater than 75 lbs. to compete in the 80 lbs. weight class.</i>
Round Lengths:	Male: Three, two-minute rounds with 1-minute rest period in-between rounds. Female: Three, two-minute rounds with 1-minute rest period in-between rounds.
Equipment:	USA Boxing will provide gloves, tape, and gauze. All other items (headgear, foul-proof cups, breast protectors, form-fitted mouthpieces, uniforms, sponges, water bottles, etc.) must be provided by the participants. Boxers must wear headgear made to USA Boxing's specifications.
