


Normal targets have a single spot per target, full 10 rings, scores 1-10 (see depictions below)
 3 or 4 spot targets: 3/4 spots per target, each has 6 rings, scores 6-10 (each 5 RING actually half the stated diameter)
 Sizes in Italics - 3 or 4 spot target mandatory for outdoor senior/collegiate/AR/junior classes; optional elsewhere.
 * An archer is considered "20 (or 17, 14, 12) or younger" until the end of the year containing the 20th (or 17, 14, 12)th birthday.
 ** An archer is considered "50 (or 60, 70) or older" from the beginning of the year containing the 50th (or 60, 70)th birthday.
 *** AR1 optionally uses special compound equipment with mechanical release that is considered to be in the "recurve" division.

Vertical Three Spot Target 	^These categories (most indoor compound) use the inner ten ring rule; all others use the outer ten ring.													
	These categories are eligible for the US Open (all qualify at the same distances and faces).													
	*** In AR1, women only qualify for US Open.													
	Each cell contains the male distance in meters (blue), female distance in meters (red), and target diameter in centimeters for a one spot target.													
	NAA Senior division is equivalent to FITA Senior division.													
	NAA Master division: all age divisions are now equivalent to FITA Master division. (All Masters compete at same distances/target sizes.as Cadets).													
	NAA Junior division is equivalent to FITA Junior division.													
	FITA also recognizes 25 meters distance indoors, as well as a combination 18/25 round, but they are rarely used in the US.													
	Archers who qualify for a particular division automatically are eligible for more competitive divisions if they choose to use them.													
	For example, cadets are eligible to compete as Junior or Senior, Masters are eligible to compete as Senior as well, using appropriate distances
