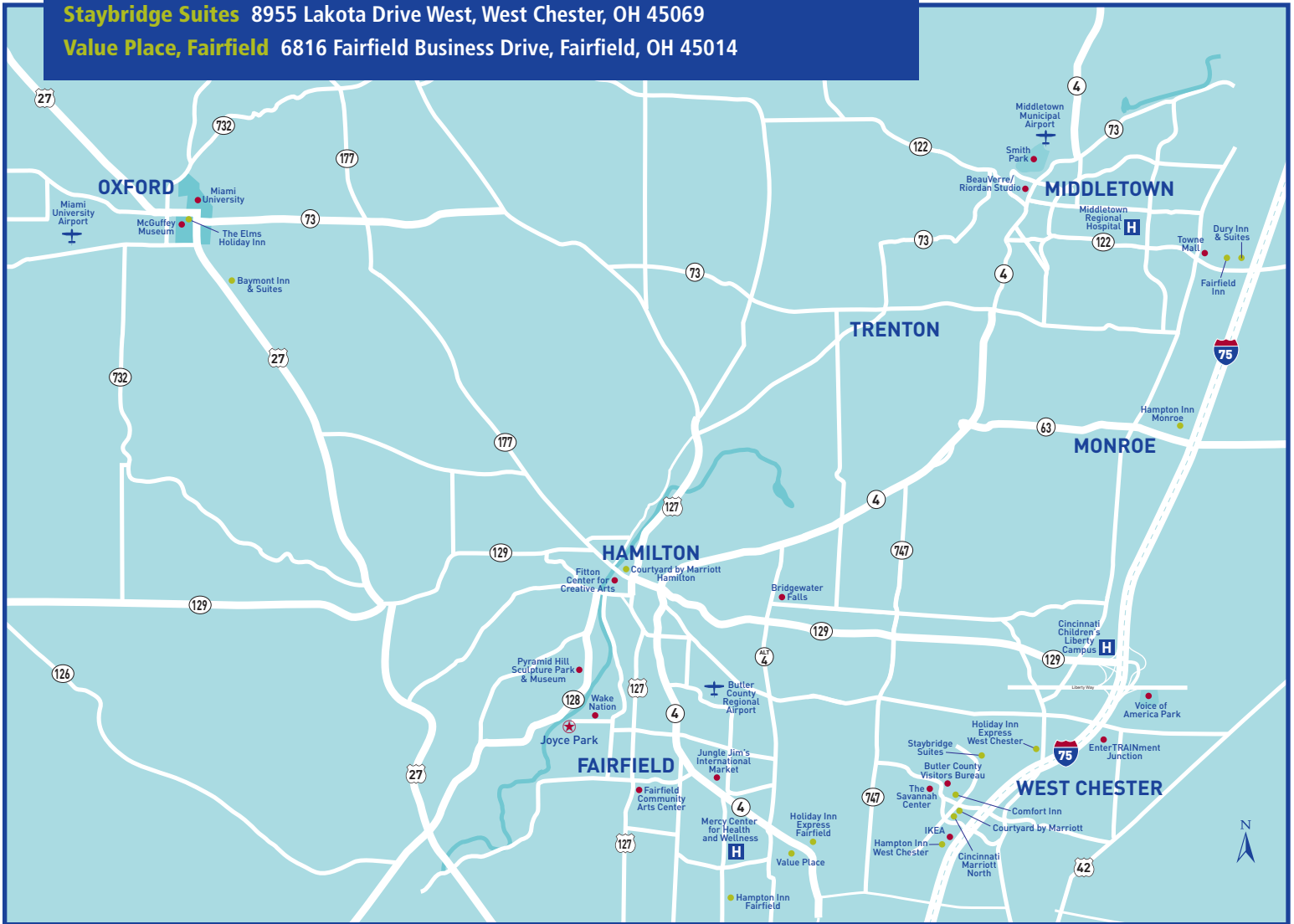

# LOCATION

## City of Hamilton

Bolstered by access to Interstate 75, Hamilton has ably positioned itself as a center of commerce, entertainment, and culture. Standing proudly as the Butler County seat, Hamilton has transformed itself from a primarily agricultural to an industrial area with impressive demographics.



In 2000, Hamilton was deemed **The City of Sculpture** by the State of Ohio due to the city's 35 pieces of sculpture, created by nationally and internationally-known artists.

The award-winning **Pyramid Hill Sculpture Park & Museum** also adds to Hamilton's sculpture-theme, featuring 265 acres of impressive artistic pieces and is just one of ten sculpture parks in the United States and the only sculpture park of its size in Ohio.

The city's culture is also highlighted by the **Fitton Center for Creative Arts**, which is home to continuous art exhibitions, a lecture series, a resident theatre company, and a performing art series.

Hamilton is also defined by its strong dedication to the past by the preservation of historic districts such as the **German Village, Dayton-Lane**, and **Rossville**. Visitors may tour these districts on self-guided walking tours to view the beautiful mansions and home of the past.

One of Hamilton's finest natural features is the calming beauty of the **Great Miami River** that flows through the heart of the city. Residents celebrate their great river city past each September with the festive Great Miami River Days, which features water sports, live entertainment, food, and family-friendly activities.

# SITE

The site for the **126th US National Target Championships** is Joyce Park in Hamilton Ohio. **Joyce Park** is a 313 acre park which provides room for activities including 20 soccer fields, a driving range and miniature golf course, and basketball along with the BMX bicycle motor cross track. The newest addition to the park is Wake Nation which opened May 2009.

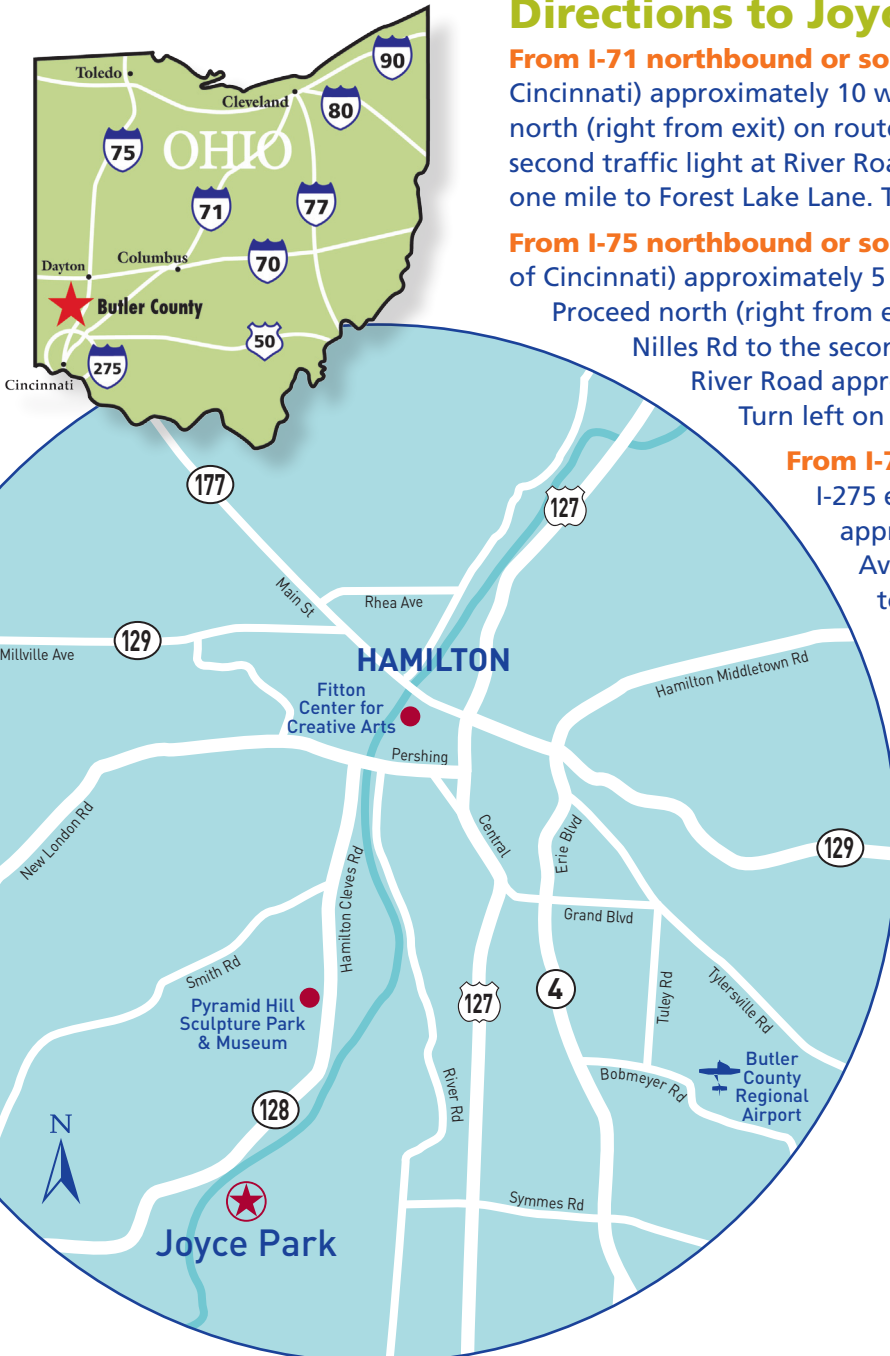
## Directions to Joyce Park

**From I-71 northbound or southbound**, take I-275 (on the north side of Cincinnati) approximately 10 west to Route 127 (Hamilton Ave). Proceed north (right from exit) on route 127 to Nilles Rd. Turn left on Nilles Rd to the second traffic light at River Road, then right on River Road approximately one mile to Forest Lake Lane. Turn left on to Forest Lake Lane.

**From I-75 northbound or southbound**, take I-275 (on the north side of Cincinnati) approximately 5 minutes west to Route 127 (Hamilton Ave). Proceed north (right from exit) on route 127 to Nilles Rd. Turn left on Nilles Rd to the second traffic light at River Road, then right on River Road approximately one mile to Forest Lake Lane. Turn left on to Forest Lake Lane.

**From I-74 east bound (from Indiana)**, take I-275 east around the north side of Cincinnati approximately 8 minutes to Route 127 (Hamilton Ave). Proceed north (left from exit) on route 127 to Nilles Rd. Turn left on Nilles Rd to the second traffic light at River Road, then right on River Road approximately one mile to Forest Lake Lane. Turn left on to Forest Lake Lane.

**From the west and I-74** - take I-275 east and exit at Route 127 (Hamilton Ave). Go north on Route 127, Hamilton Ave (Hamilton Ave turns into Pleasant Ave.) to St. Clair Ave. Turn left on St. Clair Ave. and continue through the River Road light into Joyce Park.



# TRANSPORTATION

Situated in the southeast corner of Butler County, Ohio, Hamilton is an ideal location to host the **126th US National Target Championships**. Located just miles north of Cincinnati and south of Dayton, Butler County is easily accessible both by car and air travel. Located along the I-75 corridor, Butler County is within a day's drive of 65% of the US population and is served by four major international airports.
