Qualifications for all Candidates

A director shall:

- be a citizen of the United States and eighteen (18) years of age or older;
- not be a paid employee or consultant of USA Boxing;
- be physically present at the Annual Meeting where they are standing for election;
- passed background check within two (2) years
- Any person having a record of a felony criminal conviction involving theft, financial improprieties and other crimes involving moral turpitude or has committed and been sanctioned for a severe violation of the regulations of USA Boxing or the International Boxing Association (AIBA), is not eligible to serve as a director or to stand as a candidate in any election. A severe violation is defined as one which resulted in suspension of one (1) year or more within the last five (5) years.

Chair/President Position (four year term)

In order to be qualified, the candidate must be a member in good standing and shall have been a member of USA Boxing for a minimum of 4 years. The Candidate shall submit a completed candidate packet including: Announcement of Candidacy Form, Credentials and Election Committee Profile and Resume/Vitae.

Women's Boxing Director (two year term)

In order to be qualified, the candidate must be a member in good standing and shall have demonstrated a strong commitment to the women's program. The Candidate shall submit a completed candidate packet including: Announcement of Candidacy Form, Credentials and Election Committee Profile and Resume/Vitae.

Coach Director (four year term)

In order to be qualified the candidate must be a member in good standing and shall have been a member of USA Boxing for a minimum of 4 years and achieved a minimum of the level II coach's certification. This director should be familiar with and recognize the significance of developing athletes; grass roots through elite level. The Candidate shall submit a completed candidate packet including: Announcement of Candidacy Form, Credentials and Election Committee Profile and Resume/Vitae.

Official Director (two year term)

In order to be qualified, the candidate must be a member in good standing and shall have been a member of USA Boxing for a minimum of 4 years and achieved a minimum of Level II official's certification. This director shall have as a minimum, participated as an official at the national level. The Candidate shall submit a completed candidate packet including: Announcement of Candidacy Form, Credentials and Election Committee Profile and Resume/Vitae.

Grassroots Director (four year term)

In order to be qualified, the candidate must be a member in good standing. The Candidate shall submit a completed candidate packet including: Announcement of Candidacy Form, Credentials and Election Committee Profile and Resume/Vitae.
