



## 2012 Ludus Tours Developmental Grant



The grant is made possible through a mutual partnership and vision to build the sport of volleyball. While the aim is to promote USA Volleyball and drive membership to the organization through our normal business activities, we also want to do something that helps develop the sport for the 2012 London Olympic Games (and beyond). We want to think outside the box and help drive the future by building the sport and the athletes in a positive and direct way.

Grant funds that are awarded are to be used specifically on programs that expand opportunities for boys 14 years old or younger to practice and compete at the local level. Plans should be in place to retain participants for future boys' programming within the club. Participation in the BJNC is encouraged but not mandatory for grant consideration.

### **\$1,000 Club Grants**

- Any USAV sanctioned volleyball club that is in good standing with their Region and USAV is eligible to apply for one of five \$1,000 grants.
- In order for this grant to have an impact throughout the country, only one club from any one Regional Volleyball Association can be awarded a grant.
- Grant funds must be tracked and a written account of their use must be provided to USAV by July 1 of 2012. Contents of the written program review are posted on the application.
- Grant funds must be used to develop new programming or enhance existing programming for boys ages 14 years old or younger. It is strongly suggested that the funds be used to create or improve youth leagues that cater to boys.
- A grant selection committee will be formed to review applications and determine the recipient clubs.
- Grants will be one-time payments with the condition that a written review of the programming is provided to USAV. Should a club fail to meet this requirement they will be required to return the funds to USAV for redistribution.
- Applications will be accepted immediately and will be reviewed upon receipt. Applicants will be notified when the application is received and when a decision has been made concerning the application. Applicants should expect a response within 45 days of submitting their application.

The Proposal Narrative is probably the single most influential component of the application process. In depth details of your programming expectations and intended objectives will be used by the Selection Committee to determine whether your program is more worthy of funding support than competing applicants. Only one grant will be awarded in a single USAV Region. You will be notified whether or not your program is awarded funding in a timely manner.
