



U.S. Paralympics – Military and Veterans Alpine Skiing Program

There are multiple sport classes based on impairment for athletes who compete in Paralympic competitions. The below standards are based on the IPCAS system and are consistent across all sport classes.

2010/11 U.S. Paralympics Alpine Skiing Standards

- **Elite Standard:**
 - Must be internationally classified
 - Have National [USSA] and International [IPC] license
 - In USADA out-of-competition testing pool
 - 120 IPCAS points from DH or SG or SC; **or**
 - 200 IPCAS points in GS or SL
 - Eligible for selection to international events

- **Emerging Standard:**
 - Must be internationally or nationally classified
 - Have National [USSA] and International [IPC] license
 - In USADA out-of-competition testing pool
 - 200 IPCAS points in DH or SG or SC; **or**
 - 280 IPCAS points in GS or SL

- **Military Standard:**
 - Must be internationally or nationally classified
 - Have National [USSA] and International [IPC] license
 - 240 IPCAS points in DH or SG or SC; **or**
 - 320 IPCAS points in GS or SL
