We are fortunate to have the talents of the same instructors who have led and participated in the highly successful Fencing program at Stevenson High School.

What: An 8-week Fencing program

You will learn the rules of Foil, Epée, and Saber, and will be instructed in Foil.

When: Every Wednesday night from 6:45 to 8:45, starting October 30.

Where: Sprague multi-purpose room

Who: Two instructors, both recent graduates of the successful Stevenson program, as well as administration by the Stevenson Fencing coordinator.

Class: Size will be limited to about 24 students. Each student will spend about half the class doing training/drills, and the other half doing actual bouts ('fencing').

Cost: An introductory price of only \$99 for the 8 wk session, excluding equipment.

Equip.: All fencers are required to use regulation protective mask, jacket, under arm protector, foil, and glove.

Mask, jacket and Foil may be rented for \$49.

You will need to purchase your own glove and underarm protector (about \$18 & \$24 respectively, available through the Club)

You may purchase a complete Fencing set at the Open House, at discounted prices.

What *you* need to do:

- Show up at the **Open House** on **Wednesday, October 23rd** in the **Sprague** multi-purpose room (on Riverwoods, just South of Rte 22), at about 7:15pm
- Doors & Registration open at 7:15, Introduction at 7:30, Fencing demonstration at 7:45.
- **You MUST be at the Open House to be sized for equipment.**
- Bring your checkbook. **Classes start the following week** and all Registration and Ordering must be completed at the Open House on the 23rd.
