General Information Pertaining to the 2009 WORLD INDOOR CHAMPIONSHIP: This event will be held March 4-8 in Rzeszow, Poland. The preliminary program information published by the World Indoor organizers states that March 2 is the planned date for arrival of participants, and that the practice field and local transport is available. The departure date for the USA Team will be announced at the team meeting following the trials. The Warsaw airport and the Cracow Airport are being considered as flight destinations. From Warsaw it is a 6 hour trip to Rzeszow and from Cracow it is a 3 hour trip.

USA Archery will initiate a new on line process for selected team members to use to process their World Indoor participation which will include payment of entry fees, travel (air and land), accommodations and banquet. As is always required when we send teams to World Championship events, USAA wires full payment of team entry fees and hotel accommodations 6-8 weeks in advance of the event. The on line process will provide the opportunity for team members to pay for their expenses with a credit card or by check, and full payment from each team member is required prior to leaving for Poland. It should be noted that this is an official USA Team event and all travel will be coordinated through the USAA office. **We ask that all competitors at this trials event be fully aware of this process before agreeing to be on the World Indoor Team. USAA has estimated expenses for this event so that team members will have an idea what the overall cost per person will be. The following estimates are based on the current exchange rate and for your planning purposes and should not be considered as final costs:

\$768.....International travel

\$400.....Approx. domestic travel

\$150.....Entry fee per individual

\$ 60.....Lunches on the field (5 days – optional) - \$17.....Banquet (optional)

\$530.....Accommodations (based on single room for 7 nights – double and triple rooms are optional)

\$240.....Warsaw airport to Rzeszow (this will change depending on which airport is used)

Event Format:

All archers will shoot a Qualifying Round (18m FITA I Indoor Round) of 60 arrows at 18 meters at a Vertical 3-spot 40cm face. At the completion of the Qualifying Round categories will be cut to 16 archers for the Round Robin matches. In categories with fewer than 16 archers, the category will be cut to 8. If there are fewer than 8 archers in a category, it will be cut to 4. Any position ties will be resolved according to FITA Rule 8.6.5.1. Ties for entrance into the Round Robin matches will be resolved according to FITA Rule 8.6.5.2.1. In categories of 16, each archer will shoot against every other archer in the category once (15 matches). In groups of 8, each archer will shoot against every other archer in the category twice (14 matches). In groups of 4, each archer will shoot against every other archer four times (12 matches).

FITA Rule 4.5.2.6 states Vertical triple faces will be mandatory for the Indoor World Championship. Therefore, the U.S. World Trials format will uphold FITA Rule 4.5.2.6 and make it mandatory that all archers shoot at a Vertical 3-spot 40cm face.

In the effort to keep the event on schedule and save time, archers will be permitted to inspect their targets during the tournament and change them if deemed necessary by the judges.

Day 1: Round Robin 1

- Category of 16 – First 5 matches of the fifteen match Round Robin Event
- Category of 8 – First 5 matches of the fourteen match Round Robin Event
- Category of 4 – First 5 matches of the twelve match Round Robin Event

Day 2: Round Robin 2

- Category of 16 – Next 5 matches of the fifteen match Round Robin Event
- Category of 8 – Next 5 matches of the fourteen match Round Robin Event
- Category of 4 – Next 4 matches of the twelve match Round Robin Event

Day 2: Round Robin 3

- Category of 16 – Last 5 matches of the fifteen match Round Robin Event
- Category of 8 – Last 4 matches of the fourteen match Round Robin Event
- Category of 4 – Last 3 matches of the twelve match Round Robin Event

Tie Resolution Procedures - Any position ties will be resolved according to FITA Rule 8.6.5.1 (10's & 9's). Ties at the cut-off position and Round Robin match ties will be resolved according to FITA Rule 8.6.5.2 (single arrow shoot-off). Ties in accumulated points for last team position will be resolved by 12-arrow match (3 arrow ends) followed by shoot-off, if necessary.

Standings - Total points shot in the Trials (excluding tie-breaking arrows), plus two (2) bonus points for each match won, will determine standings (under RR1 and RR2)

Category of 16 – Qualifying Round + Round Robin (240 arrows) + 30 possible bonus pts = 2430 possible accumulated points.

Category of 8 – Qualifying Round + Round Robin (228 arrows) + 28 possible bonus pts = 2308 possible accumulated points.

Category of 4 – Qualifying Round + Round Robin (204 arrows) + 24 possible bonus pts = 2064 possible accumulated points.

Team Selection/Funding - The top three (3) archers in each category will comprise the 2009 U.S. World Indoor Team. The 4th ranked archer in each category will be the alternate. An athlete may participate in a Junior Class in tournaments when the competition takes place up to and in the year of his or her birthday. ***Both the Junior and Senior Recurve and Compound World Indoor Teams will be COMPLETELY SELF-FUNDED. USA Archery will provide apparel only. Selection and funding for the coaching staff is still to be determined.***

Team Information - The team will travel to Rzeszow, Poland for the Championships to be held March 4-8, 2009. Exact travel dates and funding information will be discussed during a Team Meeting on Sunday, January 4, 2009, immediately after the team is selected. The cost for team members to attend the World Indoor Championships will be determined.

Dress Code – The NAA Dress Code will be enforced during all phases of the trial event.
