

# Coach Observer Program

The Coach Observer (CO) program is a companion program to the JDT camps. The intent of the program is to provide coaches an opportunity to observe the National Training System and interact with experienced JDT coaches and archers in an active setting. All JDT camps are led by Kisik Lee - National Head Coach.

Coaches interested in attending a JDT camp need to submit an application 90 days prior to camp. Priority will be given on the following basis:

1. Current USAA coaches working to advance to their certification, i.e. Regional working on Elite, or Community working on Regional.
2. Current USAA coaches wanting to learn more about the National Training system or working on renewal of certification.
3. Personal coaches of JDT archers.
4. USAA Board of Directors or staff.
5. Any person who has been to more than 2 JDT camps

Parents of JDT archers and Coaches not approved for Coach Observer program may attend any camp as *spectators* who observe the training from a non-involved distance.

Applicants will be notified of acceptance 45 days prior to camp. Any decision not to attend a camp, after acceptance is received, must be made on or before 30 days prior to the start of camp.

If approved to attend, CO is responsible for travel to/from camp and CO program charges of \$45/day

Spectators who wish to eat meals in the cafeteria must purchase them on site.

Once approved as a Coach Observer, coaches will be asked to complete a short survey. During camp, the CO is required to attend all meetings/classroom sessions and complete all field and written assignments. Failure to meet performance requirements will result in exclusion from future camps.

CO's must bring a digital camera, memory stick, small notebook, stretch-band, form strap and laptop in order to complete assignments. There are computers available in the Athlete Center if you don't own a laptop.
