2013 Junior USAT Qualifying Standards

Selection to 2013 Jr. USAT is restricted to USAA Members in good standing who are U.S. citizens.

Members of the NFAA may participate in the 2012 USA Archery Events without having to join USA Archery; however, a USAA Membership is needed at the time of the event to gain a ranking for the 2013 Junior USAT.

2013 Junior USAT will consist of:

- **Junior Recurve** Top (5) boys and top (5) girls
- **Junior Compound** Top (5) boys and top (5) girls

The 2013 Junior USAT will be determined by placements at 3 events:

1. **31ST Easton JOAD National Championships**

MANDATORY EVENT

- * Average of the athlete's placement in the ranking and elimination rounds.
- * Ties in the final Junior USAT ranking will be broken by the athlete's placement in the elimination round, and if still tied, the athlete's ranking round placement.

2. Next **two best placements** in the tournaments listed below:

Naming of the 2013 Jr. USAT:

* Jr. USAT designation for U.S. citizens will be awarded to the athletes eligible to compete in the Junior Division the following year (born in 1993 & later)
