2013 USAT Qualifying Standards

Selection to the 2013 USAT is restricted to USAA Members in good standing who are U.S. Citizens.

Members of the NFAA may participate in the 2012 USA Archery Events without having to join USA Archery; however a USAA Membership is needed, at the time of the event, to gain ranking in the USAA National Ranking System.

The 2013 USAT will consist of:

1. The top eight ranked senior archers, per class and division as listed in the National Ranking System.
 - a. Events included in the 2012 National Ranking System*:

i. Arizona Cup	NRS EVENT PLACEMENT POINTS
ii. Gator Cup	NRS EVENT PLACEMENT POINTS
iii. Nor'Easter	NRS EVENT PLACEMENT POINTS
iv. U.S. National Target Championships	RANKING ROUND PLACEMENT
v. So Cal Showdown	NRS EVENT PLACEMENT POINTS
vi. Texas Shootout	NRS EVENT PLACEMENT POINTS
 - b. Please refer to National Ranking System 101 for details on calculating an athlete's NRS Event Placement Point per event.
2. The winner, by class and division, of the 2012 U.S. National Indoor Championships, 2012 U.S. National Field Championships, and 2012 U.S. National Target Championships.

The 2013 USAT announcement will take place following the 2012 International Competitive Season.

**ARW2, AR Standing, Junior and Senior archers will be combined together for ranking in USA Archery's 2013 USAT Qualifier Series events, with the exception of National Target Championships. At the National Target Championships, only ARW2, AR Standing and Senior archers will be combined for ranking, since Juniors will shoot the Easton JOAD National Championships as their mandatory event.
